Submissions will be received from now to July 31, 2019. Acceptances are sent on a rolling basis. Proposals should be submitted by email to Lois Warner lmrs@rutgers.edu captioned **2019 TPAC Proposal**. They should include: 1. Presentation title and the type of proposal, whether for an individual paper presentation, panel, roundtable or workshop. 2. Each author's name, email address, affiliation, and professional title; and, 3. An abstract not exceeding 300 words. For workshop proposals, we encourage you to include a brief outline of activities that will facilitate participant engagement. If you are submitting more than one proposal, please email each separately and indicate in the subject line of each email **2019 TPAC Proposal 1 of 2**.

Early registration fees for both conference are \$185 for academics and practitioners, \$95 for students. Early registration will end on August 15, after which fees will increase to \$195 for academics and practitioners and \$105 for students. Registration includes lunches and receptions during the conferences. You will soon receive a separate email with a link for registering.
